I became, eventually, the Information Coordinator at the Dolphin Research Center, in charge of memberships, writing articles for the Dolphin Society Newsletter. Drawing upon my Communication skills, I operated video and computer equipment, including learning how to operate a Macintosh that had been donated to the organization. This is where I really caught the computer 'bug,' getting my first email account and generally getting into the entire cyber-thing! The most interesting/wonderful aspect of my three years at the DRC was all the contact I had with the animals. The Dolphin Research Center had a small staff, and so when there were major events, whether a movie production or a mass stranding or a continued care of an injured animal, all staff members were expected to do their share and 'get wet.' Life was very intense in the weird and wonderful Florida Keys, and to this day I maintain contact with the friends I made down there. I still have difficulties explaining what that life was like, when people ask. I was in Florida for three years. While in Florida I met and became friends with the science fiction author Anne McCaffrey. This friendship has seen me visiting her in Ireland, and helping her to write the science fiction novel 'Dolphins of Pern.' For various reasons, I left the DRC and the Keys behind. I often consider my leaving the DRC to be the biggest single error in my entire life... up to this point. I'll always long for Keys sunsets on the dock, with the dolphins swimming close to see what I was up to. Upon coming back to Boise, I found that I dearly missed being involved in worthwhile environmental projects with a good group of people. Using my new computer skills and my seeming ability to get a foot in a door, I became newsletter editor for the Wolf Recovery Foundation, and soon became a member of the Board of Directors. To support myself, I worked at SpectraGraphics, a computer typesetting and printing firm. I learned further skills in desktop publishing and design. I seem to be living my life in spans of three years. After that length of time in Boise, I returned to the East Coast, living in Boston this time. I went to work at Whale Conservation Institute as Graphic Designer/desktop publishing consultant. The WCI is headed by the father of whale conservation, Dr. Roger Payne. If you've seen 'In the Company of Whales' on the Discovery Channel, that's Roger. I loved New England, and hope to live in the more rural areas once again. I made many friends who remain close to this day, and plan to visit often.
